**SDNY BOARD OF JUDGES SELECTS  
BARBARA MOSES TO SERVE AS MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

The Board of Judges of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York (SDNY) has selected Barbara Moses to serve as a Magistrate Judge for a term of eight years. She will serve on the bench at the Daniel Patrick Moynihan Courthouse at 500 Pearl Street.

Ms. Moses currently serves as Counsel at Morvillo, Abramowitz, Grand, Iason & Anello, P.C. Until September, 2015 she was also the Director of the Constitutional and Civil Litigation Clinic at Seton Hall University School of Law. Previously, Ms. Moses taught at New York University School of Law and was a partner at Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe, LLP. Ms. Moses also served as President of the New York County Lawyers' Association. Ms. Moses received her J.D. from Harvard Law School and her A.B. from Dartmouth College.

"The Board of Judges is pleased to welcome Barbara Moses to the Southern District bench," said Chief Judge Loretta A. Preska. "Her experience as a litigator and academic will make her an excellent Magistrate Judge."

Full-time Magistrate judges are appointed by the District Court Judges to eight-year terms; they assist District Court Judges with the work of the court by facilitating the disposition of certain civil and criminal cases.
