STANDING ORDER

To protect public health, and in recognition of the national emergency that was declared by the President of the United States on March 13, 2020, the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York hereby authorizes the Probation Department and Pretrial Services Agency to screen persons who are serving terms of probation, supervised release, or Pretrial Services supervision and who are required to report to one of the courthouses, using temporal thermometers to determine their body temperature. If any person's temperature is 100.4 degrees or above, that person will be directed to leave the courthouse and seek medical attention.
