Law Clerks

Magistrate Judge Moses ordinarily hires for two clerkships each year. One begins in April and one begins in October. Each is for a one-year term. Open positions are posted on OSCAR, not on the Court's website.

Candidates should have at least one year of practice experience, preferably including matters in the federal courts, *before* the start of the term for which they are applying. Applications should be submitted through OSCAR and include a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, three letters of recommendation (at least one from a supervisor familiar with the candidate's post-law school work), and a recent writing sample. If the writing sample is not entirely the candidate's own work, the nature and extent of contributions from others should be noted.

Volunteer Staff Counsel

Judge Moses welcomes applications from prospective or recent law school graduates interested in serving as volunteer staff counsel, either full-time or part-time. Volunteer staff counsel are assigned many of the same duties and responsibilities as term law clerks. Applicants should send a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, letters of recommendation, and writing sample directly to chambers, addressed to Courtroom Deputy Kevin Snell. The cover letter should state clearly that the applicant seeks a volunteer position.
