I. Criminal Applications

A. Warrants

Arrest and search warrants, including applications for cell site information, triggerfish, and GPS tracking, should be emailed to

<u>NYSDRicardoCriminal@nysd.uscourts.gov</u> specifying the time that the agent and U.S. Attorney are available to swear out the complaint.

B. Late-night or Weekend Warrants

If you anticipate the need for a late-night or weekend warrant, please send Judge Ricardo an email at <u>NYSDRicardoCriminal@nysd.uscourts.gov</u>.

II. Pleas

At least 24 hours in advance of a plea, the indictment/information, plea agreement, a summary of the elements of the offense(s), and the maximum and mandatory penalties for each crime/count should be emailed to NYSDRicardoCriminal@nysd.uscourts.gov.

III. Misdemeanor Sentencing

Pre-sentence submissions for misdemeanors should be submitted no later than 2 weeks before the scheduled meeting.
