<u>Positions</u>: Judge Engelmayer has completed hiring through the 2025–26 term. With respect to the 2026–27 term and subsequent terms, Judge Engelmayer is accepting and will consider applications. Judge Engelmayer has two vacancies for the 2026–27 term. Judge Engelmayer is committed to hiring at least one of his three law clerks each year directly out of law school.

**Applications**: Applicants from graduating classes prior to 2026 may submit applications at any time and be interviewed at any time, and clerkship offers may be made at any time.

<u>Federal Law Clerk Hiring Plan</u>: Judge Engelmayer follows the federal law clerk hiring plan. Accordingly, for the graduating class of 2026, Judge Engelmayer will not conduct formal or informal interviews, or make formal or informal offers, before June 10, 2025. For the graduating class of 2027, the operative date is June 9, 2026. For these students, Judge Engelmayer will keep any clerkship offer open for at least 24 hours.

Application Process: Applicants should submit, through OSCAR, a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, undergraduate transcript, writing sample, and three letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation may be submitted separately, and should be submitted both by email and by OSCAR. Applicants who do not have access to OSCAR may email their application materials in PDF format to the email address indicated above. Applicants from the graduating class of 2026 who do not have access to OSCAR may submit email applications prior to June 10, 2025, but their applications will be reviewed consistent with the hiring plan. Application materials submitted by mail will not be reviewed.

<u>Volunteer Position</u>: Some years, Judge Engelmayer may hire a full-time volunteer law clerk, fellow, or deferred associate. If an applicant is interested in being considered for such a position to commence in 2026 or subsequent years, please follow the application process described above but indicate in the cover letter interest in being considered for a volunteer position.
