## Counsel must comply with the following requirements for all criminal cases proceeding to trial:

- 1. Any Rule 404(b) notice must be served 30 days prior to the commencement of trial.
- **2.** Any Rule 16 expert disclosures, including all required information, shall be made 30 days in advance of trial.
- **3.** Any <u>Daubert</u> motions must be fully briefed the Friday before the Final Pretrial Conference, unless otherwise specifically ordered by the Court.
- **4.** Motions *in limine* must be fully briefed before the Final Pretrial Conference.
- **5.** Not later than the Friday before the Final Pretrial Conference, the parties shall file their joint proposed jury instructions with citations to authority (in Word format with track changes/comments disagreements between the parties); proposed verdict forms (same); proposed *voir dire* (same); the Government's exhibit list, with objections and responses of defense counsel noted in the same format as governs this Judge's civil matters; a list of any proposed or likely stipulations; the Government's proposed witness list, with estimated duration of direct and cross examination.
